



PRESS RELEASE

The National Peace and Reconciliation Commission condemns in the strongest terms all forms of political intolerance and political violence before during and after the forthcoming general elections. The NPRC further condemns the incitement of young people by adults to commit crime and political instability. The use of denigrating and hate speech against political opponents is also hereby strongly condemned.

As the Commission mandated with promoting national peace, social cohesion, healing and reconciliation the NPRC calls upon all political players to exercise restraint, campaign peacefully, respectfully and in compliance with the laws of Zimbabwe. The NPRC hereby calls upon the Zimbabwe Republic Police, the National Prosecuting Authority and the Judiciary Service Commission to exercise their constitutional mandates in dealing with perpetrators of political violence without fear or favour so that Zimbabwe remains a peaceful investment destination. Peace begins with me. Peace Begins with you. Peace Begins with all of us.
